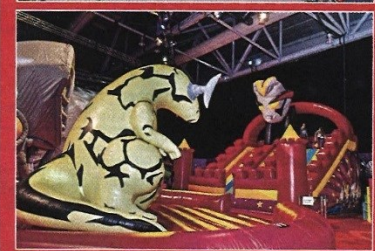




Fun alert for cartoon fanatics!

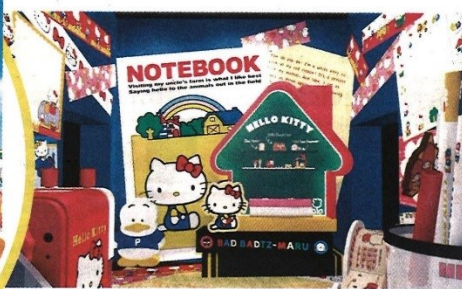
Sanrio sweethearts

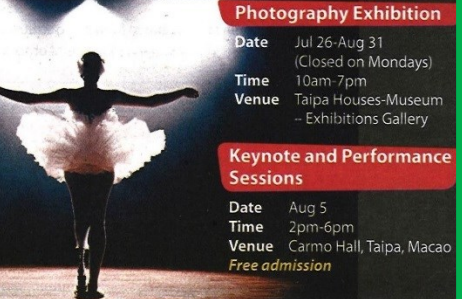


Art in unity

Integrating art, people and community with a host of social initiatives to raise awareness of the underprivileged and disabled community in Macao, Taipa Village Cultural Association partners with British Council and Macao Digital Photography Association, to present the Dream with Love campaign.

Set against the rich cultural backdrop of Taipa Village, the campaign consists of a series of art-related exhibitions and activities, including the renowned 11 Million Reasons exhibition, conceptualized by People Dancing, the UK organization for community dance. The exhibition is complemented by two series of photography – The Harmony Collection and The Dream Collection, which reveal the beauty and authenticity of disability art.

In addition, speakers from community service centers such as Macau Autism Association, the Macau Deaf Association, the Arts with the Disabled Association Hong Kong, as well as individuals like visually-impaired Ivy Kok and Macao singer Romeu Choi Assis, will perform and share their own life experiences in tackling disabilities.
